V. Two Letters of Recommendation (no family members)

Dilley 4-H Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Must be a Senior Member in good standing of the Dilley 4-H Club, faithfully attending meetings all 4 years of High School.
2. Must be enrolled in a public, private, or home school and be in good standing with the school.
3. Must attend an accredited University, College, Technical or Trade Institution, or enlist in the Military upon graduation from High School. Please submit an Acceptance Letter from the College or University of your choice or Proof of Enlistment from the branch of service selected.
4. Must complete application, write essay, and provide two letters of recommendation by the April 1st deadline.

Tier Point System Guideline:

Tier 1 - \$2,000 Scholarship (75+ points)

Tier 2 - \$1,500 Scholarship (45 – 74 points)

Tier 3 - \$1,000 Scholarship (18 – 44 points)

Point Determination:

(9th-12th grade)

- **GPA** - 2.0-3.0 = 1 point
3.1-4.0 = 2 points
4.1+ = 3 points
- **Years active in Dilley 4-H** = 1 point per year
- **Dilley 4-H Attendance** = 1 point per meeting
- **Dilley 4-H Club Participation** = 1 point per event
- **Dilley 4-H Club Role** – Elected Officer = 2 point per year elected
Ran for an Officer Position or Served on a Committee = 1 point per year ran/served
- **District 12 – 4-H Competition Involvement** = 1 point per event
- **Frio County Jr. Livestock Show Participation** = 1 point per year
- **Country Store Participation** = 1 point per year
- **FCJLS/Country Store Awards** - Grand Champion = 3 points
Reserve Grand Champion = 2 points
Showmanship = 3 points
- **Major Show Participation** = 1 point per show
- **Essay** = 1 - 5 points based on committee review
