



DRESS CODE

Exhibitors are required to wear a collared shirt that is tucked in and will stay tucked in during the SIFT, SHOW, and SALE

No Shorts or T-shirts will be allowed. Wearing any type of advertisement for alcohol, tobacco, or any other vice is prohibited.

There will be **NO** hats or caps worn by exhibitors during sift, show, & sale. Exhibitor helpers are required to wear a collard shirt in the show ring. Not following the dress code will be grounds for disqualification.

This award is given annually to a graduating senior in memory of Gracen Gulick.

Qualifications:

- Must be a graduating Senior (12th grade)
- Must have exhibited an animal at the stock show or Country Store either current year or past year(s)
- The individual will be given credit if he/she completes the Quality Counts Program
- The individual must demonstrate outstanding courtesy, helpfulness and support during the stock show or preparation for the stock show
- The recipient of the award will be selected by a committee appointed by the Frio County Board of directors.



The Pet Parade will be held in the Frio County Junior Livestock Show ring immediately after the swine show on January 26th. Your Cloverbud can bring a pet or just walk through. <u>Please make sure to fill out the sign up sheet and have a parent or responsible person present for child to be in the</u>

<u>parade.</u>

Rules:

1. No competition, participants receive awards

Animals appropriate for this age group include bucket calf, sheep, swine, goat, dog, poultry, rabbit, cat, companion animal or stuffed animals.

All animals must be on a leash or in a cage and have proper vaccinations and/or current tags for rabies.

4. Calve or other animals weighing more than 350 pounds at time of parade are not allowed or appropriate for this age group.

5. All animals must be able to be controlled by the child. If not, do NOT bring to show grounds

6. No entry fee. One item/animal allowed for parade

7. Turn in sign-up entry sheet at Extension Office by 5 PM, January 12th, 2024

8. Clover kids participating in the parade need to follow the FCJLS dress code
